Dear Friend:

On January 12, 2010, Haiti was wracked by a magnitude 7.0 earthquake that killed over 200,000 people. Although it is no longer in the headlines 5 years later, Haiti is still far from rebuilt. Infrastructure for basic services, including healthcare, remain woefully underdeveloped.

The Rasin Foundation is a Boston-based 501(c)3 organization that launched the Petite Rivière Community Health Center in Leogane, Haiti, after the devastating earthquake of 2010. The health center's nurse and support staff see hundreds of residents each month, in collaboration with various volunteer physicians, dentists, nurses, mental health workers, physical therapists and other practitioners traveling from the United States to assist our community when able.

Over the past year, the Rasin Foundation has continued its mission to help the community through health improvement and community development with a number of projects including:

1. Enhancing the dental services at the clinic.
2. Expanding nursing coverage including to a local school part time.
3. Holding a training for area-wide nurses to enhance their skills in multiple areas including family planning, diabetes management, cholera prevention, and sexually transmitted illness management and prevention.
4. Welcoming several medical missions from the US to assist in the medical care of the community.
5. Installing wired electricity to permit improved lighting and eventually additional testing and treatment capabilities.

On October 4, 2015, the Rasin Foundation will hold its 6th annual benefit at Elm Bank in Wellesley, Massachusetts. The event will feature live music, a fashion show from renowned designer, Prajje, and a silent auction – all set against the backdrop of authentic Haitian cuisine.
